Scott Broski has been working for the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORSD) since 1994. He is currently the Manager of the NEORSD's Water Quality & Industrial Surveillance (WQIS) department.

Mr. Broski oversees the day-to-day operation of the WQIS department and a staff of 25 responsible for the industrial pretreatment program, mercury program, various business programs and the environmental assessment program. The department also responds to emergencies, such as chemical spills and odor complaints, involving the collection system and the environment.

Mr. Broski serves on the Ohio EPA/Ohio Water Environment Association (Northeast Section) Industrial Pretreatment Committee. The committee plans and holds quarterly pretreatment workshops for Industrial Pretreatment Coordinators in Northeast Ohio. He is also a member of the National Association of Clean Water Agencies Pretreatment and Pollution Prevention Committee and the Northeast Ohio Environmental Crimes Task Force.

Mr. Broski earned his B.S. in Biology from Syracuse University and his graduate M.B.A. degree from Cleveland State University. Mr. Broski holds a Class III Operator of Wastewater Works license from the Ohio EPA.
